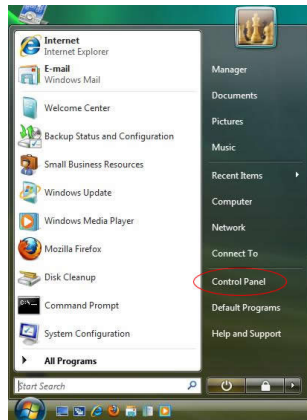
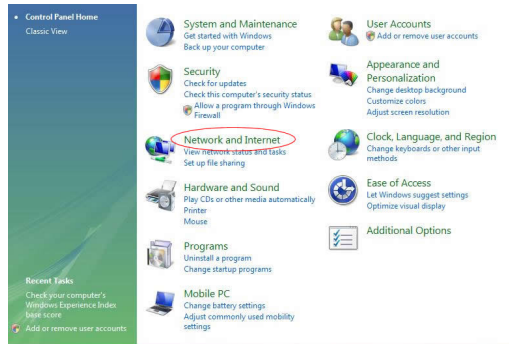


Setting up a dial up / ISDN connection in Windows Vista Business

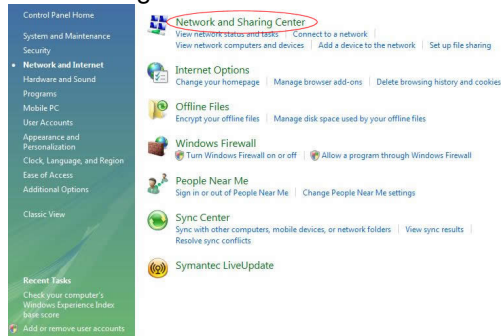
First of all, click on the windows button located in the bottom left, then “Control Panel”.



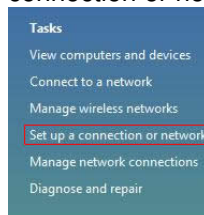
In Control Panel select the option “Network and Internet”.



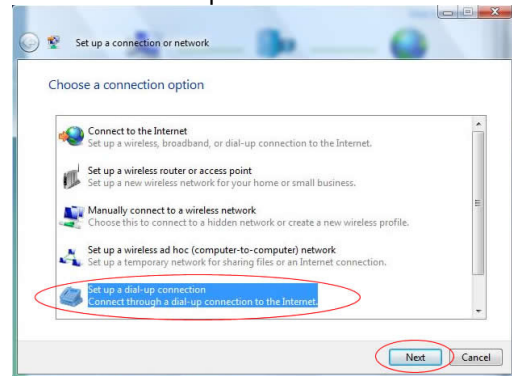
In Network and Internet, select “Network and Sharing Center”.



To create the connection select “Set up a connection or network”.



Then select the option “Set up a dial-up connection” and press Next.

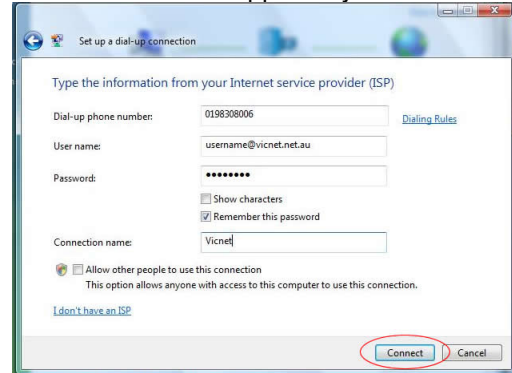


On this screen, enter the phone number, then the username and password. Select “Remember this password” then call the connection Vicnet. After this has been done, select Connect.

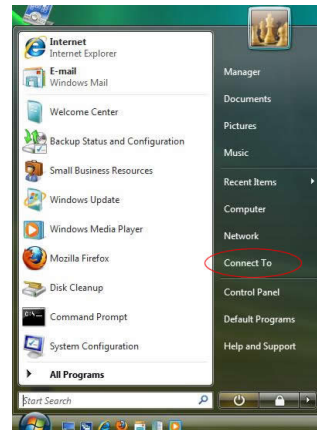

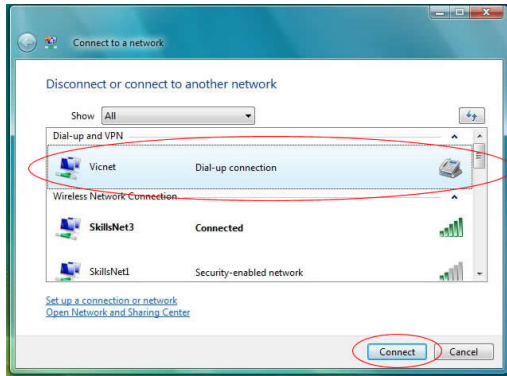


If this works successfully it will then tell you “the connection to the internet is ready to use”.

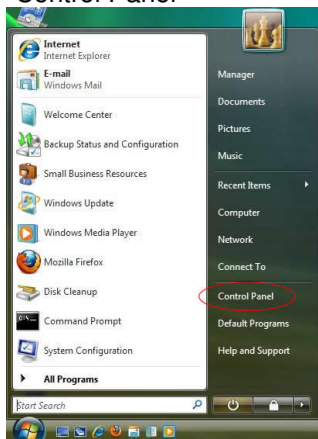
To access this in the future click on the windows button and then “Connect to”.



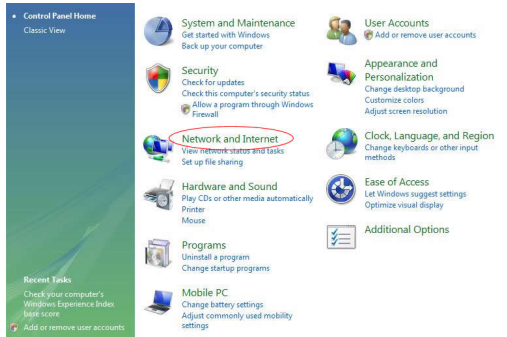
From here select the Vicnet connection and press “Connect”.



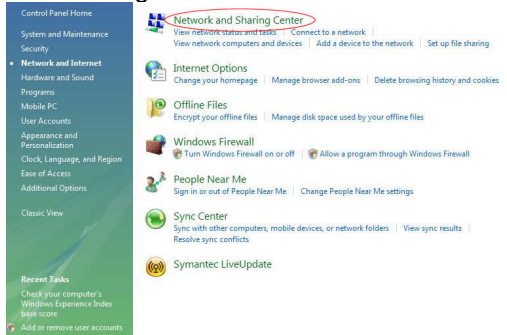
To create a shortcut to the desktop click on the windows button again, then "Control Panel"



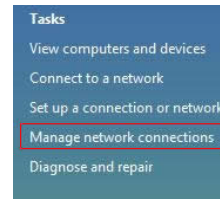
In Control Panel select the option "Network and Internet".



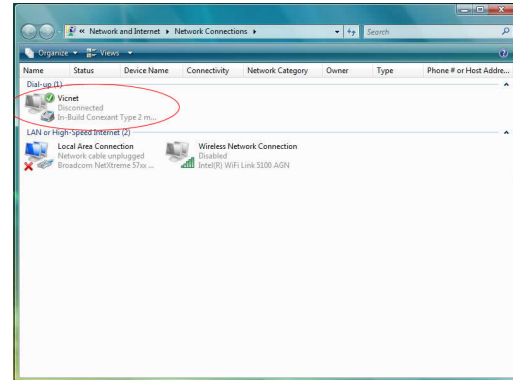
In Network and Internet, select "Network and Sharing Center".



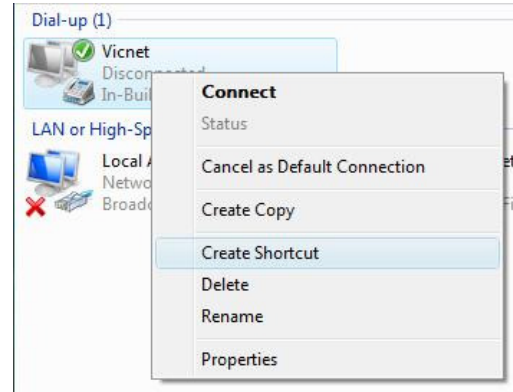
Then select "Manage network connections".



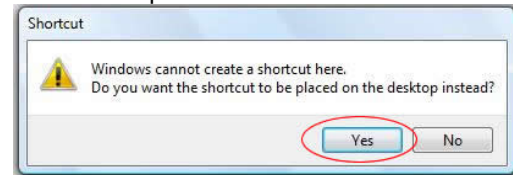
You should see the Vicnet Dial-up connection here.
